Answers

8. c - Lambert was on all four Super Bowl teams, was seven times an All Pro, and was named to the all-decade team in the 1970s and the 1980s, but he was never Super Bowl MVP.

9. a - The Broncos and Patriots have fewer combined wins in their 12 appearances (5) than the Steelers have alone.
